

GEORGE R. GUTLICH's PRINTS

From March 24 till June 4, 2018

Meeting with the artist march 24, 2018, 2:00 pm, at the Museum

The Xylography Museum will choose , each year, an engraver to be proclaimed Artist of the Year, and will joint some of his prints to exhibit in the first temporary expositions.

This year, the elected was George Gutlich, which woodcuts and etchings will be exposed from march, 24 till june, 4.

In the opening day the artist will talk with the visitors at 2 PM in the Museum.

George Rembrandt Gutlich was born in São José dos Campos, São Paulo State, Brazil, in 1968. In his fifty years life he lived several lifes, so much was the variety and the number of works he developed in the Fine Arts field.

Graduated at São Paulo Fine Arts School, he specialized in Museology, at the Institute of Museology of São Paulo; Master at the University of Taubaté; PhD in Arts, at the State University of Campinas; and Post-Doctorate, at the University of Lisbon. He taught, for decades, in various educational institutions and developed teaching career at the University of Taubaté. Recently, he also achieved the position of Adjunct Professor at the Federal University of Minas Gerais. He is author of the book "Arcadia Nassoviana".

Exercising his talent in the Fine Arts fields, he is present specially in graphics, both etching and woodcut, at tens of collective or one man exhibitions, so in Brazil and abroad.
